- EOR refined information list for 1W1P plan development
- Data collection phase (handout)
 - Explanation on the prioritization process
 - Further refinement, starting with broad topics and boiling down to a comprehensive watershed priority scheme and ultimately an implementation plan
 - EOR will be reviewing documents/plans between now and October and identify priority issues and implementation strategies
 - EOR will present a summary of plan review in October
 - o It will be a running list, so plans can be added as necessary
 - County Comprehensive Plans can be submitted as a part of this process as well

Zonation

- Two handouts
- Completed for watershed in 2013, based on social values of survey participants
- Four steps of process
 - o Pick out parameter concern areas, watershed attributes.
 - Biology, Water Quality, Hydrology and Geomorphology, Connectivity, Agriculture
 - Assign values to these aspects. Series of pair-wise comparisons to establish ranking system
 - o Run the model, stacking items of importance
 - Priority areas are identified.
- Product is dependent upon those who completed survey and their results
- LiDAR didn't exist when this was completed initially, could revisit zonation to have this added. Other layers are same/similar.
- Zonation survey can be revised to have additions.
 - Irrigation data? # of pivots
 - Urbanization around lakes
 - Stream power index
 - Buffer protection map and county ditch data
 - Drinking water supply management areas
- Wouldn't be a significant process to update model

- Planning committee would take survey, 30-60 minutes
- Policy committee could do broad comparisons
- Could wait until PTMapp is completed for those results to be included into Zonation model
- Surveys could be completed online and incorporated into 1W1P prioritization process
- Layer selection can be completed at October meeting with synthesis review results from EOR on priority issues.
- The prioritization survey will be sent out electronically after the meeting to be completed prior to the November meeting, with zonation model ran and completed in November.
