- Final Citizens Advisory Committee Meeting will take place in Mid-August
- Discussed Measurable Goals for:
 - o Drinking Water Protection
 - No high nitrate concentrations are currently noted within the Pomme de Terre Watershed, though education and continuing partnerships and county programs related to well monitoring and sealing will continue to protect vulnerable Drinking Water Supply Management Areas into the future.
 - o Surface Water-Groundwater Interactions
 - Continued gathering of data related to groundwater is needed in order to move forward with future protection/improvement strategies. (i.e Groundwater Restoration and Protection Strategies, hydrologic atlas, etc.)
 - o Impaired Lakes, Protection Lakes, & Shallow Lakes
 - Discussed external and internal lake loading, lakes with feasibility for change within the first 10years, recreationally valued lakes, goal-setting for nutrient reduction (using Lake-management plans or the Nutrient Reductions Strategy Goal of 12%).
