Federal Partner Programs:

- Alan L. (NRCS), Bruce F. (USFW), and Kerry Z. (FSA) discussed their respective programs.

Implementation Plan Subcommittees:

- Water Quality (Oct. 24th)
 - o Discussed how to track BMPs and find current baseline.. Potentials for an interactive map/ArcGIS-online type of tracking. Tracking management practices is much harder.
 - o Measuring local goals: Number of fields/landowners contacted within a priority area
 - o Measuring state goals: TP and TSS reductions (PTMApp) – need baseline.
- Altered Hydrology (Oct. 25th)
 - o Measuring goals through acre-ft of storage gained through practices
 - o Storage through management practices –harder to track. Management practice use is in constant flux (moving fields, changing practices, etc..)
 - o PTMApp helps highlight priority areas for storage but can't look at in-stream erosion.
 - Could use 10-year geomorphic surveys with WRAPS to calculate erosion rates.
- Groundwater (Oct. 24th) – TIER II Goals
 - o MDH reached out to public water suppliers and Rural Waters – priorities include sealing wells. Goal on how many we could seal a year?
 - o Surface-Groundwater interactions: Activities fall under education and data collection.

Implementation Schedule / Programs

- Group reviewed current drafts – comments and discussion. A new draft will be sent the group to review on their own.
- When scheduling 10-year funding needs, the group would like to account for inflation.
